City tour of the Old Reims and its cathedral

This ancient university town lying on the banks of the river Vesle is famous for its magnificent cathedral, where French kings were traditionally crowned, as well as the Basilica St Remy, Reims is also, together with Epernay, the Capital of Champagne and most cellars are open to public. The Cathedral Notre Dame: owing to its homogenous architectural style, its superb sculptures and its spiritual role over more than a 1 000 French and European history, the Cathedral Notre Dame, undoubtedly deserves to be considered as one of the finest cathedral in Christendom.



Ruinart caves



Founded in 1729, 60 years before the French Revolution, the House of Ruinart is one of the oldest champagne houses in France. The company slogan "Wines of power and finesse" sums up the house style which is both elegant and majestic. Sourcing their Chardonnay and Pinot Noir grapes from the best villages in Champagne (grands crus and premier crus), makes Ruinart champagne an art form. Mature, rich and full-bodied, "Dom Ruinart" is sublime and "Exclusive" beyond belief! Ruinart is owned by Moët Hennessy, WINE and CO's shareholder.

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Veuve Clicquot



The history of the Home begins in 1772, when Philippe Clicquot publishes one formal defense in the Newspaper of France announcing that he "funds a trade of wines under the sign Clicquot".

In 1798, his son François, who has just married Barbe Nicole Ponsardin, takes back the Home. It dies prematurely in 1805 but madam Clicquot will follow her work with tenacity, boldness and passion.

A marvellous history begins then: the birth of a big wine of Champagne region and the revelation of a "great lady of the Champagne region". "The single quality, the first one".

In the middle of Reims, unless 2 hours Paris time, our Gallo-Roman crayères waits for your visit. Several thousand champagne bottles rest, in silence and half-light there. Step by step, you will discover the magical world of the Home widow Clicquot Ponsardin there.

We promise you a visit which alloys with our history the fundamental stocks of our Home: Tradition and Modernity, Quality and Innovation.
